

Freight calculation – sea freight LCL

Freight calculation for LCL loads – the respectively higher value applies – volume or gross weight

Weight/Measurement (w/m) per freight ton (f/t) in ship's option

Sample calculation: one crate in LCL traffic

$$1.20 \times 0.80 \times 1.20 \text{ m} = 1.152 \text{ cum}$$

$$1.152 \text{ cum} \times 1,000 \text{ kg} = 1,152 \text{ kg chargeable}$$

If the crate weighs more than 1,152 kg, the real weight shall be taken as a basis for freight calculation. If the crate weighs less, the calculated value (volume \times 1,000) applies.

Thus:

Volume in cum (length \times width \times height) \times 1,000 kg = chargeable weight.

The chargeable minimum is 1,000 kg.

Legal documents

The most important bills of lading

The **Received for shipment B/L** is issued when the goods have been taken over for transport by the forwarding agent, even if they are not loaded yet. By note: "shipped on board", which has to be signed, the received for shipment B/L turns into an on-board B/L.

With the **On-board B/L, Shipped B/L** the forwarding agent confirms by the stamp „Shipped on-board B/L“, „Shipped B/L“, „actually on board B/L“ or „since shipped“, that the good have been loaded onto a ship mentioned in the bill of lading. As a rule an on-board B/L is required for business by letter of credit to confirm the handover.

Bill of lading as security

The bill of lading represents the goods shipped and thus is a goods security. It can be handed over, sold, purchases or pledged instead of the good. Usually, the bill of lading mentions an authorised person (exception: bearer bill of lading, partial bill of lading with several authorised persons). It documents the promise of the forwarding agent to surrender the goods to the legitimate owner of the document. Often it is used in conjunction with a letter of credit.

Bill of lading as receipt

Basically the bill of lading is a receipt. By means of the bill of lading, the forwarding agent confirms that he has taken over the consignment for transport.

Bill of lading as document of proof

In cargo operation, the bill of lading is a documentary proof for the content of the contract of affreightment concluded between the shipper and carrier, if no special booking note has been issued. The conditions of transport are defined in the clauses of the bill of lading. If bill of lading and contract of affreightment deviate from each other, the conditions of the bill of lading shall be applicable for the receiving party. Only if the receiving party is the carrier at the same time, the conditions of the contract of affreightment shall be applicable.



Short-Sea Container

Container turns into lorry

Apart from the classic standard containers, short sea transport uses pallet-width 45 inch container. Thus the inside dimensions correspond to the dimensions of a classical lorry.




Panama – maximum size

In order to permit ships to pass the Panama Canal, they may have a width of 32.20 metres and a length of 300 metres maximum. Depending on the type of constructions, ships of 4,000 to 5,000 TEU can pass through the canal and thus have the "maximum Panama size". If the dimensions exceed those of the locks, ships are known as "post Panama max ships".

Suez Canal – maximum size

In order to permit ships to pass the Suez Canal, they may have a width of 77.49 and a height of 68 metres maximum. The maximum draught must not exceed 20.10 metres. As the Suez Canal has no locks, there is no length limitation. As a rule, the draught is the limiting factor for tankers as well as container ships.

Intelligently combined

Sea/Air combination solution in LCL traffic

Less expensive than pure airfreight, but, double as fast as classic sea freight. Sea/Air combination offers a real alternative for our customers who seek inexpensive means of transport without having to do without short times.

An example: Sea freight from Chittagong (Bangladesh) to Dubai in a fortnight. From Dubai by aircraft to Frankfurt, Düsseldorf or Hamburg in 1 to 2 days results in a total transport time of 15 to 16 days! This produces saving of 10 to 12 days compared to classic sea freight. The following applies: The closer the departure location is to the aviation hubs, the higher the reduction in transit time.

Freight calculation - airfreight

Freight calculation for airfreight – the respectively higher value shall apply – volume or gross weight

Specimen calculation: one crate in air transport with 100 kg:

$$\begin{aligned}1.20 \times 0.80 \times 1.00 \text{ m} &= 0.96 \text{ cum} \\0.96 \text{ cum} \times 166.67 \text{ kg} &= 160 \text{ kg volume weight}\end{aligned}$$

Also:

Length x width x height (in m) = cum. x 166.67 = volume weight

In this case a chargeable weight of 160 kg would be applied.



EU customs clearance/tax representation

In the Netherlands we offer EU customs clearance as well as the advantageous handling by tax representation, which again provides a higher liquidity.

Because: Handling goods for free traffic by tax representation means that the advance payment of import VAT (EUTax) is not required for customs clearance at Rotterdam port. This gives you a considerable liquidity benefit because no permanent tie-in period of the paid and not reimbursed import value added tax occurs.

Your benefit for this reason: No advance payment of the EUST / BTW / VAT et cetera of the respective EU destination country, for export to goods into an EU country under tax representation.


